TYPE OF FERTILISER: Ammonium sulfate + 24 % S
MINERAL SIMPLE SOLID NITROGENOUS FERTILISER WITH SECONDARY NUTRIENT; N (S) 20 (24)

DECLARED CONTENT:

AMMONIACAL NITROGEN (N-NH₄)	20.0 %
SULFUR (S) soluble in water	24.0 %

APPLICATION: Intended for complete nitrogen nutrition of all plant species, on neutral and alkaline soils especially with sulfur deficiency, and for those plant species that require a larger amount of this nutrient (rapeseed, cabbage, etc...). The recommended amount is 100-500 kg/ha/year. On acid soils recommended intake is 120 kg CaCO₃ with 100 kg of fertilizer. It is used in the treatment of primary tillage or prior to the seeding. Treatment should be carried out 1-3 times a year up to the recommended annual amount. It should be applied across the land, spreading evenly over the entire surface. Avoid surface application on lime soil in the absence of moisture, to prevent volatilization of nitrogen. Avoid intake of fertilizers (in quantities over 100 kg/ha) at the same time with the seed due to the potential influence on germinating seeds.

STORAGE: Fertiliser is packed in 25 kg PE bags on pallets, collectively protected by plastic wrap or in BB made of PP/PE. Store and keep in closed, semi-closed or open warehouses, at moderate ambient temperature and precipitation conditions. Closed warehouses should be dry and have natural air ventilation. For fertiliser stored in semi-closed or open warehouses at temperatures over 32 °C or in rainy conditions, further protection is necessary from heat/moisture by covering it with a waterproof, dark covering. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, chemicals and pesticides. Stack it up in maximum two pallets (2m).

DATE OF EXPIRATION: Unlimited, provided it is properly stored.
